Clear filter sheets allow maximum transmission of visible light while bronze and blue colored sheets significantly reduce visible light transmission. Features include shatter-resistant, lightweight construction which can be sawed, drilled, and routed. Each sheet strongly resists many chemicals including ammonia and dilute acids.
